Level: 1 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

Level: 3 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

Level: 6 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

Level: 7 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

1. **Psalm 100**- Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing. Know that the Lord is God. It is he that made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name. For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures for ever, and his faithfulness to all generations

2. **Jeremiah 6:16**- This is what the LORD says: "Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls.

4. **John’s Intro**: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it...He was in the world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him. But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God, who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the will of man, but of God. depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Level: 9 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

1. **Luke 23:44-46** It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon, for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.
2. **John 15:7**- "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
3. **I Corinthians 10:13**- No testing has overtaken you that is not common to everyone. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tested beyond your strength, but with the testing he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to endure it.

Level: 10 Date Mastered: Reward Unlocked:

1. **1st John 1:9-** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
2. **1st John 2:15-16-** Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world--the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life--is not of the Father but is of the world.
